The College began its journey 65 years back with the mission and vision of imparting education for the holistic development and empowerment of the girl students, mainly refugees from the then East Pakistan, and since then it has never stopped trying seeking new avenues to fulfill its goal. Post-Covid, the College has initiated a series of efforts to supplement the conventional chalk-and-talk method of learning and equip the students with facilities that are intended to bring out the best in them and fulfil their potential. With a view to enhance their classroom experience, the institution has insisted on ICT –based teaching method; Career Councelling Cell conducts 30-hour sessions to equip learners with the skills and inputs required to enhance their employability in the job market. Since the main thrust is imparting education, all efforts have been taken to equip them with books, journals and other resources through a fully automated library with facilities like INFLIBNET, OPAC, and a reprographic centre. Laboratories of Science Departments and a Computer Laboratory add to the theoretical knowledge of the students. The various cells and committees work throughout the year to focus on the socio-cultural events that contribute to shaping them into socially responsible citizens.
