#### Subject code: ENG for English

- 1. Following the NEP 2020 guidelines, following five (5) types of courses are offered in English
  - a. MAJ: Major courses
  - b. MIN: Minor courses (for students who are not ENG majors)
  - c. SEC: Skill enhancement courses (for ENG major students)
  - d. AEC: Ability enhancement courses (compulsory for all students of second semester)
  - e. MDS: Multi-disciplinary courses (open to all students, i.e. both ENG majors and those who are not ENG majors)
- 2. Explanation of a course code? For example, for course code MAJ201, MAJ stands for major course. For all other course codes refer to abbreviations used in the above list. This is followed by the numeral 2. For all course codes this refers to the semester level of the course. A minor (MIN) course can be offered for both Semesters I and II and IV, but it will be referred to by the first semester they are offered. Next two digits (in this case 0 and 1) refer to the serial number.
- 3. Credit score and Marks division of the above courses:
  - a. MAJ: 60 (end-term)+15 (internal assessment) [6 credits]
  - b. MIN: 40 (end-term) +10 (internal assessment) [4 credits]
  - c. SEC: 35 (end-term) +10 (internal assessment) [3 credits]
  - d. AEC : 40 (end-term) +10 (internal assessment)[4 credits]
  - e. MDS: 35 (end-term) +10 (internal assessment) [3 credits]
