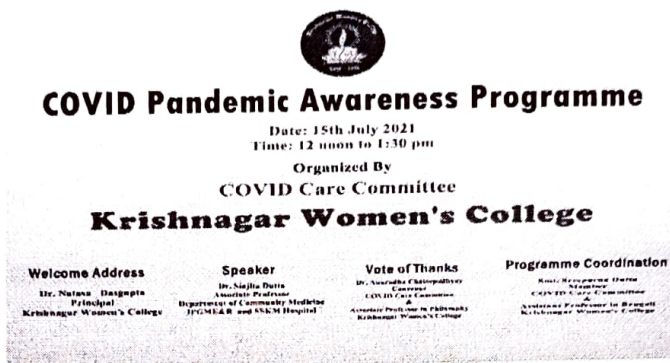


REPORT on COVID PANDEMIC AWARENESS PROGRAM

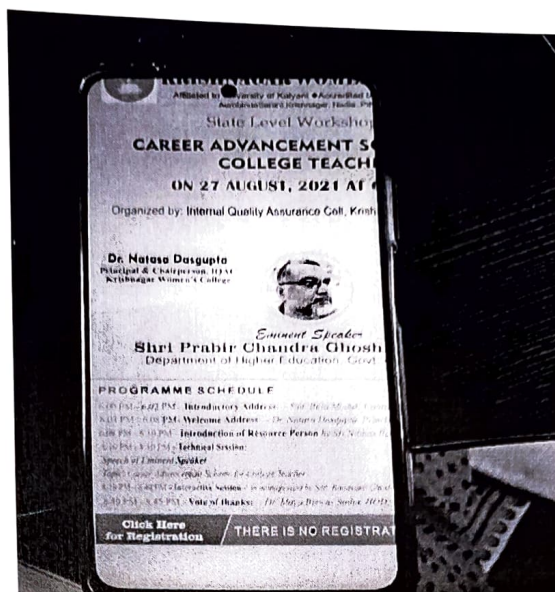

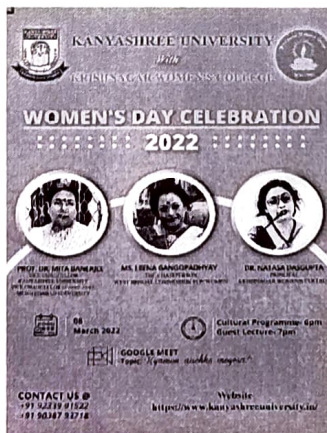
KAMON ACHHE MEYERA

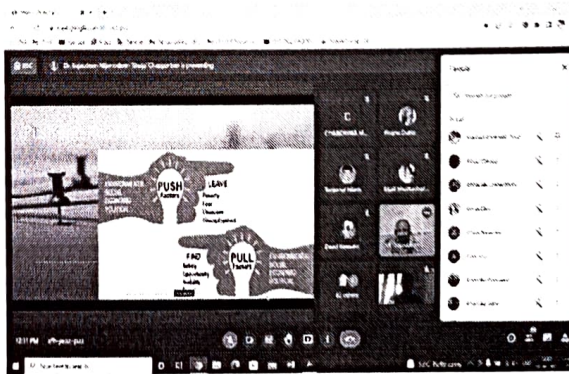
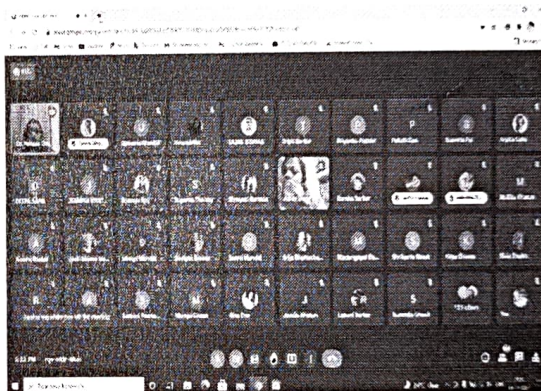

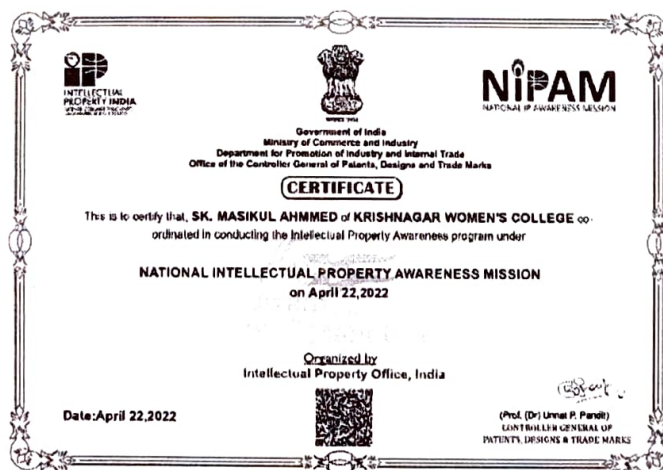

Programme**

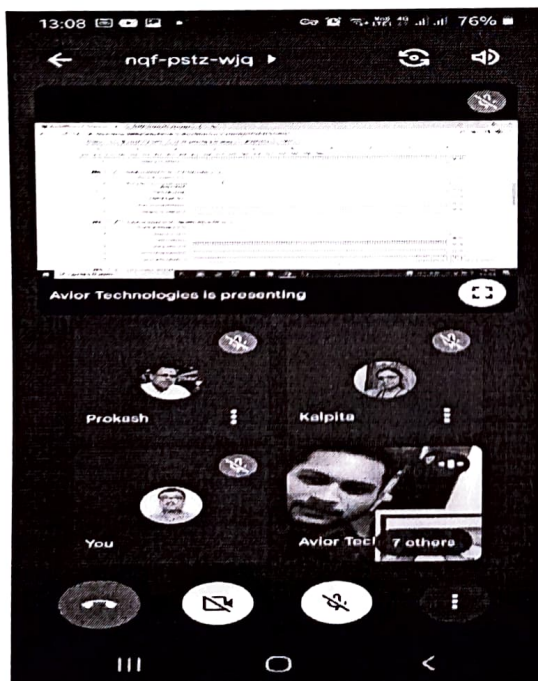

After that some students of NSS Unit, Krishnagar women’s College presented a show of some basic yoga posture in front of the audience. After this Session a lunch break was taken.

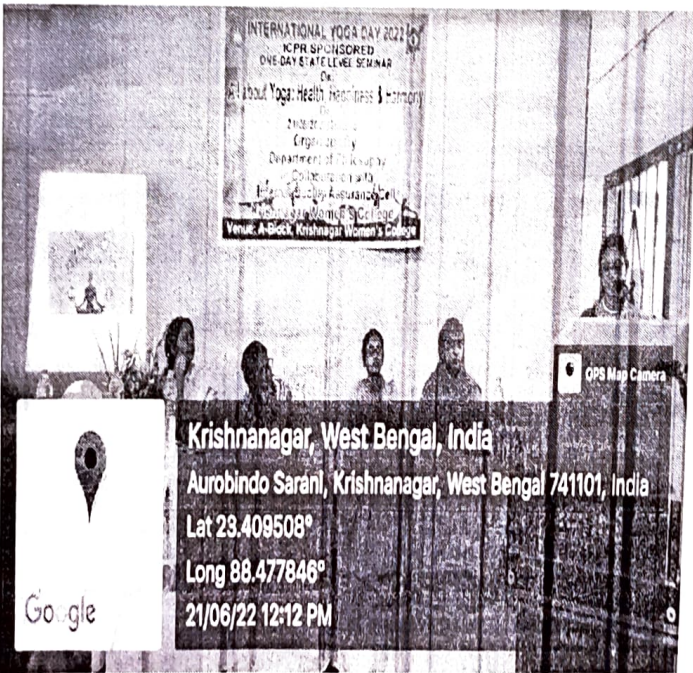

Report on “Domestic and Sexual Violence – Legal Safeguards”

Internal Complaint Committee of Krishnagar Women’s College organized a webinar on “Domestic Violence and Sexual Harassment – Legal Safeguards” on 23.06.2022 through google meet platform to address the issue of domestic violence and sexual harassment of women at workplace. Total 78 students including teachers participated in this webinar. The young generation of girl students are the potential employees in public or private sector organization. The seminar was organized in making the students as well as teaching and non-teaching staff of the college aware of the possible threats to their dignity in their future workplace and the ways and measures that they can have recourse to in case of any harassment from the other employees of their workplace. The speaker, Prof. Mala Ghosh, Associate Professor of Bengali introduced the speaker, **Smt. Aindreela Chakraborty, Advocate, High Court, Kolkata**. The women, being the vulnerable section of the society. She explained the different types of domestic & sexual violence and brief history of violence. Domestic violence is a serious social problem and a national health concern with significant impacts on individuals and our communities. The cause of domestic violence are spousal disparity in educational attainment level or marital age, lack of autonomy within the home, dowry pressure, child hood abuse, unemployment etc. Exposure to violence can increase the risk of smoking, alcohol and drug abuse, mental illness and suicidality, chronic diseases like heart attack, diabetes and cancer, social problems such as crime and further violence. She addressed different types of domestic violence. These are sexual, emotional, psychological, spiritual, cultural violence, verbal and financial abuses. She also highlighted on domestic violence Act, Section 498-A and 304B of the India Penal Code introduced in 1983 and 1986 is often invoked in such cases. She Dowry Prohibition Act, Sexual Harassment at Workplace Act, Immoral Trafficking Act, which are applicable of Indian Penal Code relating to Women, Pocso Act. There was a very meaningful interactive session proved to be very encouraging as the participants both from teaching and as well as from students wrote their observations in the chat box as well as asked their speakers a volley of questions to satisfy their queries. They got acquainted with the existing laws and were sensitized on domestic violence and sexual harassment in the workplace. The webinar ended with vote of thanks from Dr. Maya Biswas (Sinha), ICC, Chairperson to the speaker, Principal, Dr. Natasa Dasgupta of our college and to all participants.
