

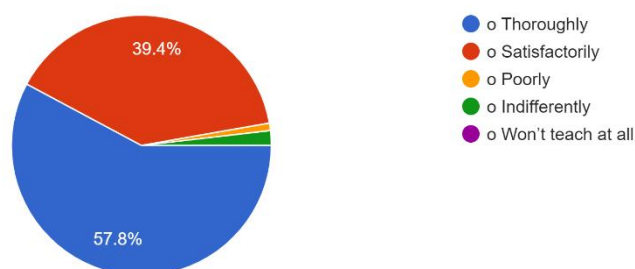

For the AQAR (2021-22), Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was conducted among the students of the college 2021-22 final year student. The questionnaire has been framed based on NAAC guidelines. We have received 109 responses from our students. The summary is presented in the form of pie chart.

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class

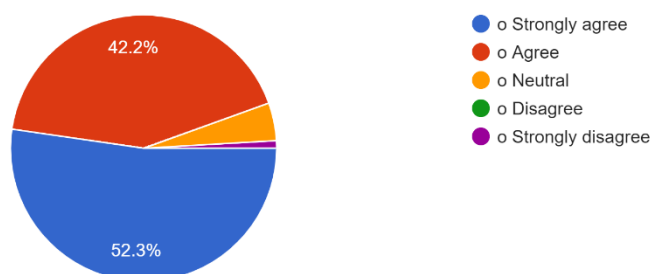
109 responses



Observation: The above pie-chart is designed on the completion of the syllabus. Out of 109 responses, a large share of students (i.e.57.8%) responded that the syllabus was completed thoroughly; 39.4% responded that the syllabus was covered satisfactorily. It appears that maximum number of students are happy with the teaching-learning process of the institution.

2. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

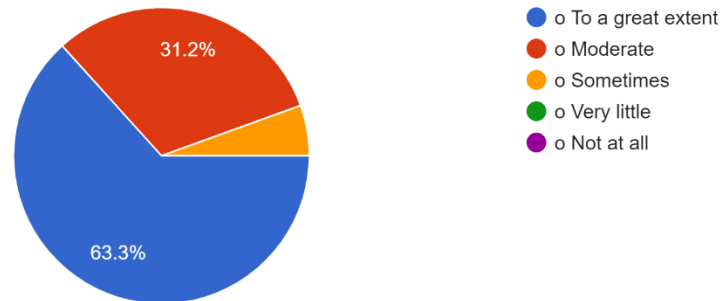

Observation: The graphic result shows that 52.3% of students strongly agree with the institutional efforts to engage them in the continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process, while 42.2% agree that the institution takes effective measures for the academic improvement of the students.

3. The institution/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

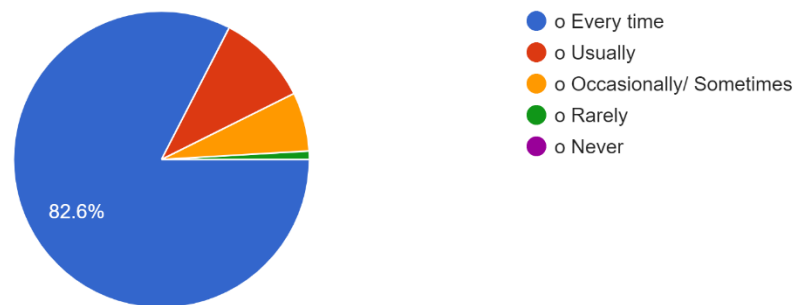

Observation: It appears from the chart that 63.3% of students responses are affirmative and 31.2% rated it as 'Moderate'. A very few students opted for 'Sometimes'.

4. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

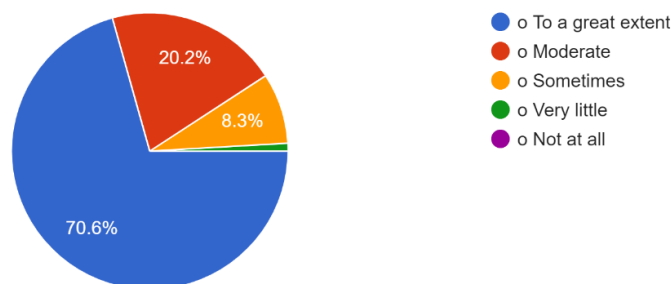

Observation: Most of the students have responded enthusiastically while rest of the others go for 'Usually' and 'occasionally'.

5. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

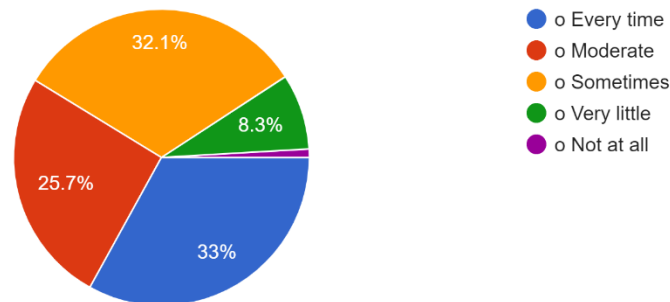

6. Percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. While teaching.

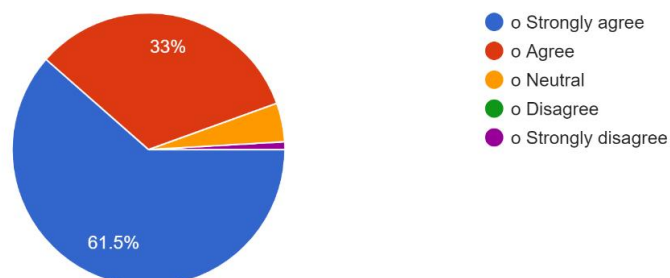

7. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

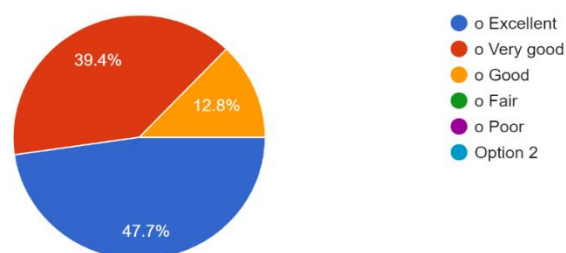

8. Academic Environment of the College

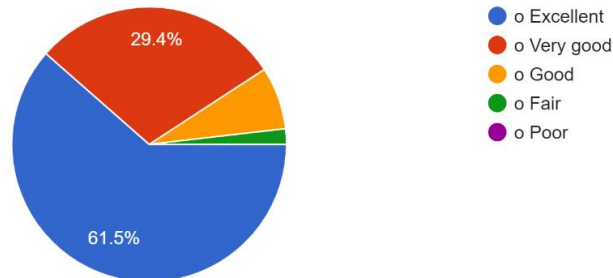

9. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes

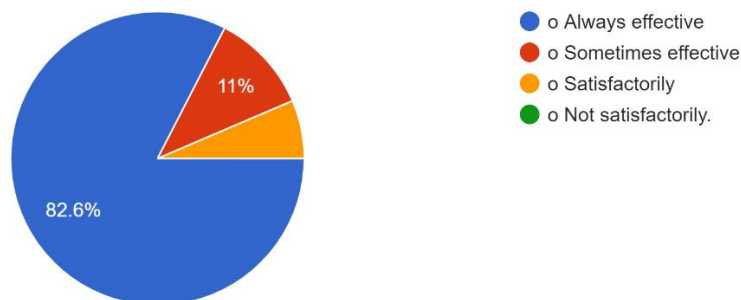

10. How well were the teachers able to communicate

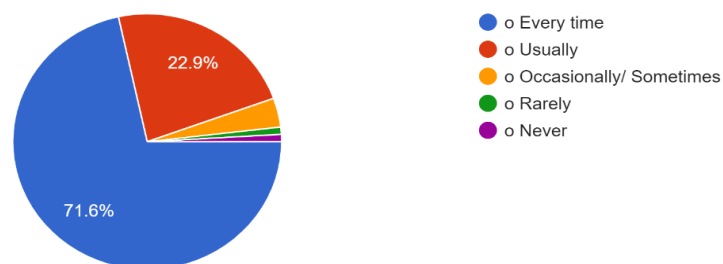

11. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

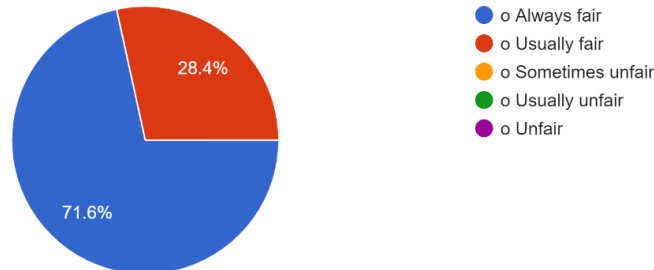

12. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

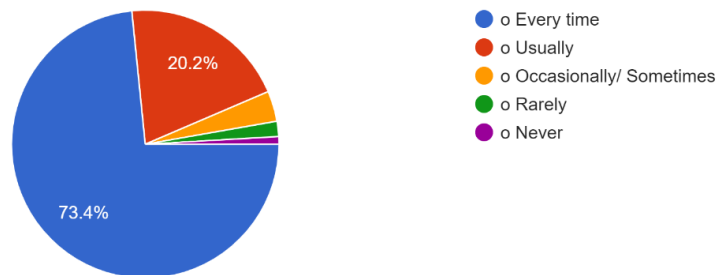

13. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you

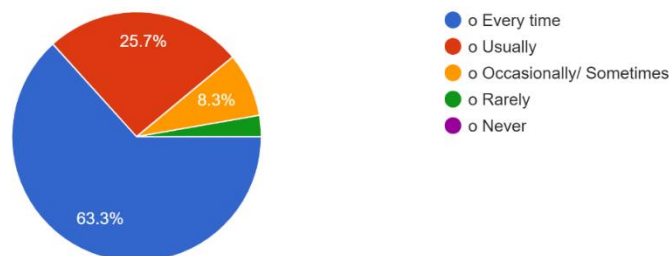

14. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

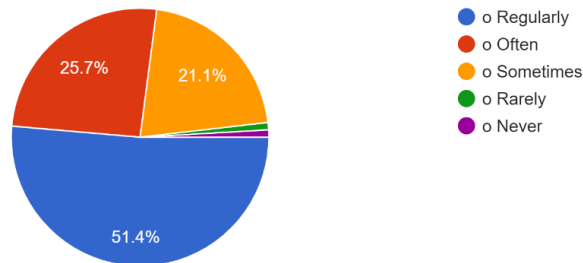

Observation: A large section of students(63.3%) appreciate their mentor for necessary assistance and follow up and rest of the others (25.7%) usually are find help from their mentors.

15. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

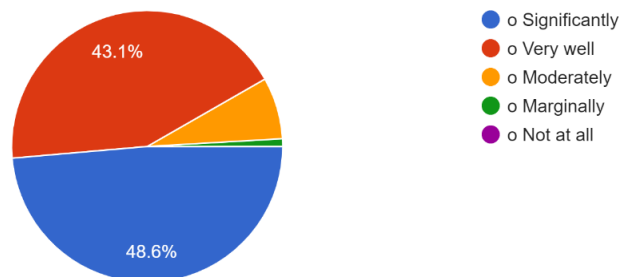

16. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

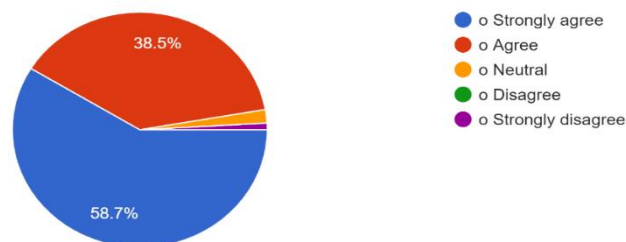

17. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

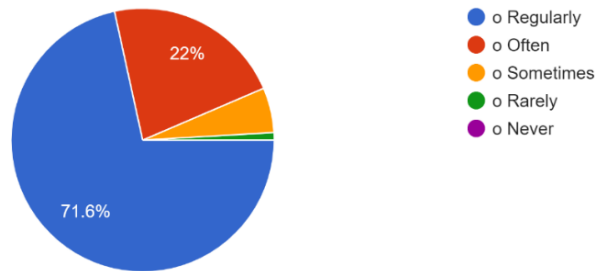

18. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

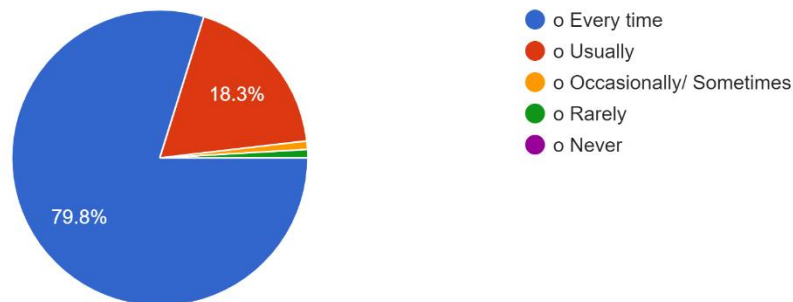

Observation: A large section of students (71.6%) agree that the teachers regularly inform them about the course outcome and programme outcome, thereby fostering their intellectual growth. 22% opine that they often monitor their academic growth.

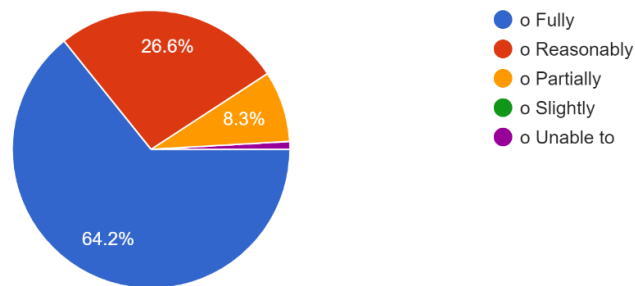
19. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

Observation: A majority of students appreciate the efforts of the teachers to substantiate the concepts through examples and applications; for 18.3% of students the teachers usually illustrate the subject through examples and applications.

Observation: The chart shows that 64.2% of students admit that the teachers fully identify their strengths and guide them to choose the right path. For 26.6% they reasonably identify their strengths and provide guidance to them.
