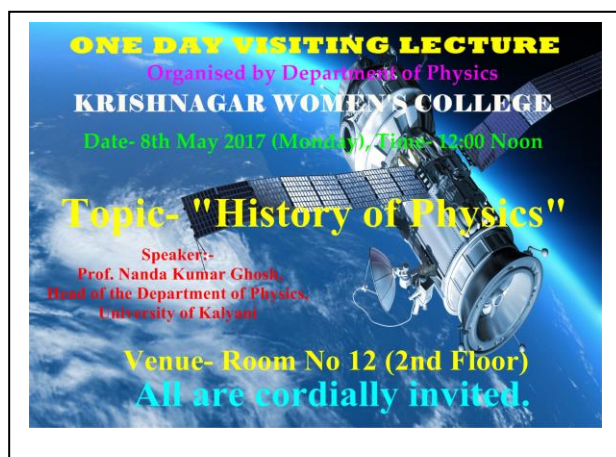
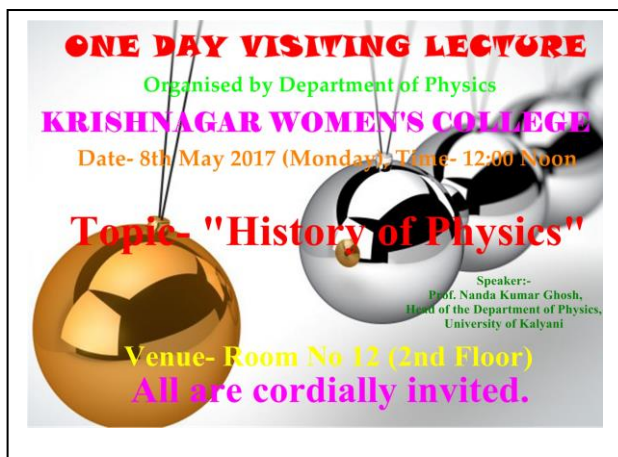
Date: 8th May 2017 (Monday)
